Chapter Five

The Parliament's legislative function

Article 73

[...]

2. Bills pertaining in any way to the granting of a pension and the prerequisites thereof shall be introduced only by the Minister of Finance following an opinion by the Court of Audit; in the case of pensions burdening on the budget of local government agencies or other public entities, Bills shall be submitted by the competent Minister and the Minister of Finance. Pensions must be proposed by means of special Bills; the insertion of provisions pertaining to pensions in Bills introduced to regulate other matters, is not permitted under penalty of nullity.
